

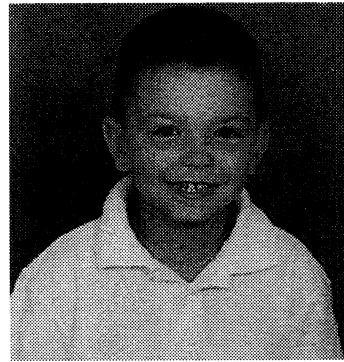
## SUNSHINE CHILD AND GRANDPARENT

## EVERY MEMBER ASKED TO FULFILL ENROLLMENT OBLIGATION

Every member of the Loyal Order of Moose is asked to fulfill an obligation he accepted the night he was enrolled by sponsoring "Just One" member between now and April 30th.

In his introduction letter to the "Just One" campaign, Director of Membership William Airey reminded our Lodge officers that new members strengthen our Order, ease the fraternities financial emergency, create new energy and ideas, offer new leadership, provide additional Lodge income, offer new leads for more members, lend an extra hand in serving our communities, and provide essential support for Mooseheart and Moosehaven.

"In addition to the dues that each new member provides to your Lodge", said Airey, "some \$34 immediately goes towards the day-to-day operation of Moose International, Mooseheart and Moosehaven, without anyone having to write a donation check. Just think what would happen if every member met their obligation - in just one year, Moose International would receive nearly \$34 million to assist in meeting the current financial emergency (\$34 per enrollee; \$20 in enrollment fees and \$14 in ABCD Dollars). Truly, a burden heavy to one is borne lightly by many."

When a member has sponsored "Just One" member during the four-month campaign, the Moose fraternity will bestow upon them the honor of being a Deputy Membership Department Motivator. Each honored deputy will receive a special kit that includes his gold deputy badge, his personal copy of the Membership Department's informational booklet, Enabling You to Make a Difference, and two more membership applications. [This is in addition to any recognition earned in the "Heart of it All" campaign, the Moose International 5 Club, the Moose 25 Club, Director General's Circle of Distinction, and any awards being issued by the Membership Department Support Teams (Purity, Aid, Progress and Wisdom).]

Members that sponsor three new or former members during this period will have their name placed on a special list of members, one of whom will be selected during the 115 th International Convention in Chicago to receive a seven- day Alaskan Cruise for two aboard the magnificent cruise ship, Carnival Spirit. If the selected sponsor qualified for membership in the 2002 Moose International 5 Club, he will receive \$1,000 towards his travel expense to Alaska. Lodge Governor Fleisher is making a plea to every member of our Lodge to sponsor "Just One" member in support of this campaign, before the April 30 deadline. He has asked the Membership Committee to promote the program by using this tool to complete as many new-member quotas as possible during the 16-week campaign.

While the Board of Officers realize that many members will sponsor multiple applications during this special period, the secret to the success of the overall program is for every member to at least do what he said he would the night he became a member of the fraternity - and sponsor "Just One". Then, motivate other members to do the same!
